I haven't commented on this site before, but I'd like to weigh in on the "remarried" convo.

I remarried in March 2002. In spring of 2003 a professing friend asked me if I'd like to come to the gospel meeting (and bring my new husband and two very young babies). My husband said he'd never stand in my way of how I wanted to worship and he was also willing to come with me as a family.

My professing friend said he asked Dale Schultz about inviting us and Dale said he'd have to pray about it. A few days went by and word came back from Dale that he'd prayed about it and he felt that it wasn't a good idea for me to attend gospel meeting here in Regina as I wasn't a good example to the young people and he didn't want them thinking it was okay to do what I did. He said we could, however, drive to Moose Jaw for gospel meeting where less people knew me and my situation.

Against my better judgment, we went to one gospel meeting in Moose Jaw. In light of the current situation, just think about the number of abuse cases that seem to be much lower on the "seriousness" scale than a terrible person like myself who....gasp....remarried. He had zero idea why I left, my exit letter to Lloyd Kneesch was ignored (no response). I spent many years deconstructing and reconstructing.

The Jesus I know and love is a Jesus I never knew before.
